

Obituary Form, Standard-Examiner, Ogden, Utah

The Standard-Examiner charges a fee for publishing obituaries in print and online. The amount is determined by the number of lines in the obituary. Single photos are included in the measurement so there is no extra charge for processing the photo. The current cost is \$2.45 per line. The sample obituary below contains approximately 44 lines, and with name headline; the fee for it would be \$112.70, plus a one-time courtesy charge of \$2.50 Monday – Saturday and \$7.50 for Sunday, first-day publications. The courtesy charge covers 10 copies delivered inside our market, or 10 tear sheets, by mail, if outside our delivery area. These figures are for estimation only. Flags for veteran's obituaries or religious emblems add 2 additional lines each. Double picture obituaries add 18 additional lines to the cost of the obituary for billing purposes. The Standard-Examiner needs the following information about the person responsible for the cost of the obituary.
