

## FIRST TEAM

**Jen Hazlett, MVP**

**School:** Syracuse  
**Year:** Senior  
**Position:** Small forward  
**Height:** 5-foot-11  
**On the court:** Hazlett,

a three-year starter and three-time All-Area selection who has signed with Army, averaged 17.2 points (season-high 36 versus Roy) on 50.2 percent shooting — 36.5 percent on 3-point attempts (35 3s) — and 68.0 percent free-throw shooting. She also averaged 5.4 rebounds, 2.1 assists, 3.9 steals and 1.1 blocks for the state 5-A champion Titans.

**Coach Rob Reisbeck's comments:** "Jen's leadership was the biggest attribute to our team. She led by example."

**On the court:** A first-year starter for the Silver

Wolves, Bell averaged 12.9 points and 9.0 rebounds per game for the Region 1 co-runner up (14-9 overall, 11-5 league). Bell also averaged 2.8 steals and 1.4 assists per game.

**Coach Larry Hadley's comments:** "Kelsie scored in double figures in 21 of the 23 games we played this year. She was our leading rebounder and drew the assignment of guarding the opponent's best post. We asked a lot out of Kelsie and she delivered night in and night out. Her strength as a player was to work hard every day. She was as blue collar as you can get."

**On the court:** Berry averaged 13.7

points (season-high 25 versus Monticello) with 20 3-pointers and was a 67.0 percent free-throw shooter. She also averaged 3.2 rebounds, 1.0 assists and 2.2 steals for the Jayhawks (11-11 overall, 6-2 Region 17), who made the state 1-A tournament.

**Coach Rick Stoekli's comments:** "Katie was our scorer and outside shooter. She could score from the perimeter or take the ball to the basket. Katie shot 96 free throws, which is huge for a '2' guard. Katie was focused, and while not a vocal leader, she still led by example."

the reason the Scots made the state tournament for the first time since 2001-2002. Broad averaged 10.82 points (season high 25 points vs. Northridge), nine assists and five rebounds per game. She also contributed 2.1 steals per game.

**Coach Andrew Short's comments:** "Kambri is the leader on and off the court. Her ability to run the offense and get her teammates involved is incredible. Kambri attacks the basket and sets the tone for the way we play offense and defense. She is a very good basketball player and student."

starter for the Lakers, Buckway averaged 14 points and 2.0 assists per game. She hit a 4-A best 54 3-point field goals, while shooting 40 percent from behind the arc. She also added 2.2 rebounds per game for Bonneville (11-11 overall, 8-7 Region 5), which advanced to a state 4-A crossover game.

**Coach Mike Russell's comments:** "The biggest thing Val brought was consistency. When we needed a score, we could rely on Val to come through. This season she developed into more of a scorer. She is also a great defensive player."

**Coach Larry Hadley's comments:** "Not many people know this about LaChere, but this year she was playing on two bad knees. We decided we wouldn't talk about her knees to anyone on the team except the trainer. She never once used it as an excuse as she led our team on and off the floor."

She also averaged 1.6 rebounds, 2.4 assists and 2.6 steals for the Region 1 champion Titans (16-0).

**Coach Rob Reisbeck's comments:** "Kiana's role was to run the team on offense, where she did a great job. She was also a big key — as our first line of defense — in our 2-2-1 press."

She shot 48 percent from the field and had two triple-doubles and six double-doubles.

**Coach Brad Matthews' comments:** "Ashley is a great player with exceptional talent. She always gives 100 percent effort in practice and games. She is a complete player."

**Coach Lisa Dalebout's comments:** "Jordan night in and night out was asked to defend the best post player on the floor; she would have to keep them off the boards. She was successful because of her hustle and her desire to do a great job on each defensive possession."

**Coach Rob Reisbeck's comments:** "This season, Brittney developed a perimeter game to compliment her strong inside game. Brittney assumed a leadership role this season. The sky is the limit with her."

She also averaged 4.4 rebounds, 1.1 assists and 1.2 steals for the Lancers (10-11 overall, 8-8 Region 1), who lost a state 5-A crossover game.

**Coach Van Price's comments:** "Addi carried our team, and the key was to get her the ball."

**Coach Brad Matthews' comments:** "Chelsea was our leading point scorer, and played a huge role in our team's success. She hit many big baskets that turned the momentum in our favor. Chelsea is a great student."

**Coach Shara Fernandes' comments:** "Jasmine was fun to watch. She did everything. She did it getting double and triple-teamed. She is an immense talent and the work ethic to go with it."
